Qualifications:

Good interpersonal skills; computer and social media skills. Passionate about working for justice and voter participation. Preference for people from diverse backgrounds. Shows respect for people from various faith and cultural traditions.

Responsibilities:

- 1. In coordination with a MUUSJN GOTV Organizer, makes contacts with people from the following communities to encourage them to get registered, consider absentee voting and voting in the 2020 election. Target groups for GOTV outreach include: Unitarian Universalist; United Church of Christ; Jewish community; other faith groups; and persons from communities with a lower propensity to vote, including: LGBTQ+ communities; people of color; Native Americans; Latinx persons, women, youth, returning citizens, homeless persons; and others;
- 2. Use one or more of the following activities to reach out to and encourage the target populations to vote in the 2020 election by engaging in activities such as: virtual forums, phone banking, on-line voter registration and requesting of absentee ballots; literature drops; social media, texting, action alerts, etc.;
- 3. Coordinate the above effort with MUUSJN GOTV staff, including: the Interfaith GOTV Campaign Manager, the LGBTQ Justice Organizer; and MUUSJN GOTV Organizers. Participate in MUUSJN GOTV on-line training and support sessions;
- 4. Document and submit reports to the MUUSJN's Campaign Manager and Director on progress in achieving project objectives;
- 5. Submit reimbursement requests to the Director no later than the 5th of each month;
- 8. Other duties as may be identified by the MUUSJN GOTV Campaign Manager and the MUUSJN Director.
