Take What You Need—And Give All That You Can! Stewardship of the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of Central Michigan

We offer one another so many opportunities for spiritual growth, exploration, and healing. Joining hands, we are guided by love as we work to transform ourselves and our world. As Drew says, *we take what we need and give all that we can*.

Or do we?

Some of us really do give *all that we can*. Many of us frankly look at what our community means to us and pledge based on that sense of personal benefit.

Considering the life-saving and life-transforming benefit to so many others, perhaps we should extend ourselves and really *give all that we can*. Drew challenges us to live up to our stated values.

But even if you do pledge commensurate with what you yourself take from our community, then consider that *what we are all getting from UUFCM has significantly changed with arrival of Andrew Frantz.*

Attendance is up dramatically, but it is not just numbers. One board member said, "The air in the room has changed." With his ministry, we feel a genuine enthusiasm, a deep enjoyment of celebrating together on Sunday morning (and at other times).

We can afford to employ Drew this year because we have some savings, but we are now depleting them. Our current pledge levels are simply not high enough to support any full-time minister.

We are at a crossroads. Can we significantly increase our pledge commitments so that we can continue to have a full-time professional minister?

The transition team reminds us that even though we offered a good salary, we were able to recruit NO qualified person to this position until we found Drew. The only other two candidates withdrew from the search and took other jobs, one in a larger city and the other on the East Coast.

So: If we cannot increase our total pledges by about 25%, we are likely not only to lose Drew but to be hard pressed to find other well-qualified professional leadership.

Review the proposed budget, listen to testimonials, and consider what you can do to strengthen and sustain our community. How will you share your time, talent, and treasure? Are you ready to challenge yourself in a new leadership role within the Fellowship? Assist with Sunday services? Join the Fellowship and make your first pledge? Or are you already a member and feel inspired to increase your pledge? What have others been giving?

Based on confidential information from our Treasurer: This current year pledging units (individuals or families pledging together) committed approximately as follows:

19% pledged less than \$500 30% pledged at least \$500 but less than \$1000 19% pledged at least \$1000 but less than \$2000 16% pledged at least \$2000 but less than \$4000 9% pledged at least \$4000 but less than \$7000 7% pledged \$7000 or more

The three largest donors funded 1/3 of our total budget.

Key to Each of the Categories:

Accounting & Bank Fees: Pays for checks, bank fees, and accountant services.

Building Costs: Pays for utilities, repairs, maintenance, improvements, cleaning, snow removal, lawn mowing, etc. **Child Care:** Pays for weekly services and special events.

Copies and Postage: Pays for purchasing stamps, post office box rental, copying of orders of service, directories, annual reports, music, and other documents.

Fair Share Payments: Payments to the UUA and MidAmerica Region.

Insurance: Pays for building, liability, and workman's compensation.

Minister: Pays for salary, housing, benefits, and ministerial expenses.

Music: Pays for substitute pianists, hymnals, music purchases, and piano tuning.

Religious Education Expenses: Pays for fees and expenses for OWL training, education materials, snacks for special occasions, decorations, and craft items.

Religious Education Director: Pays for a ¼ time RE Director.

Secretarial: Pays for contracted administrative assistant.

Supplies & Miscellaneous: Pays for food and drink items; kitchen, building, and bathroom supplies; worship supplies; office supplies; etc.

Leadership Development: Pays for expenses at UUA and MidAmerica Regional Conferences.

Minister's Discretionary Expense: Provides seed money for the minister to provide monetary aid for those who ask the church for help.

Endowment Contribution: Our yearly contribution to our Endowment Fund.

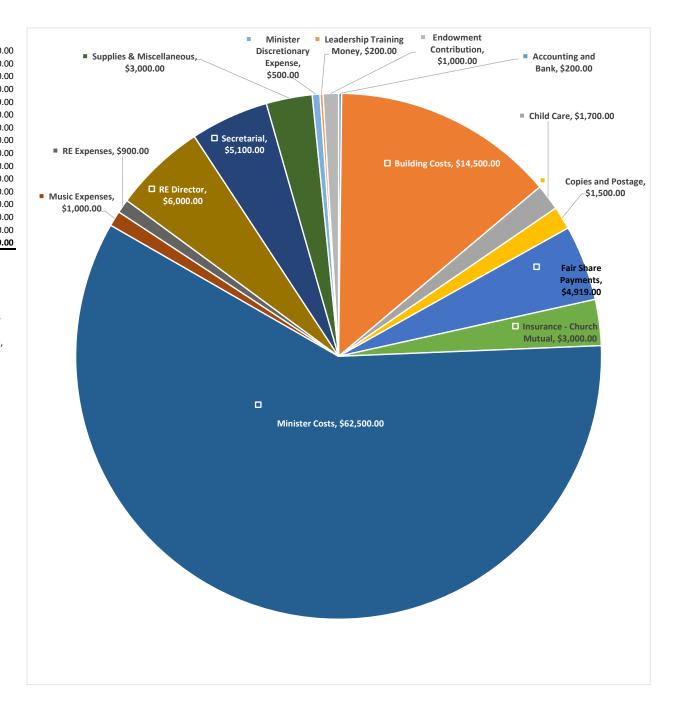

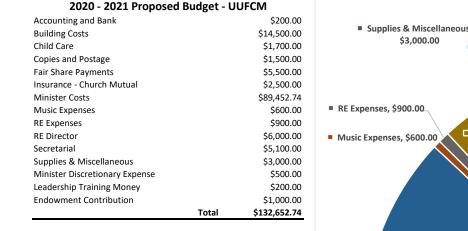

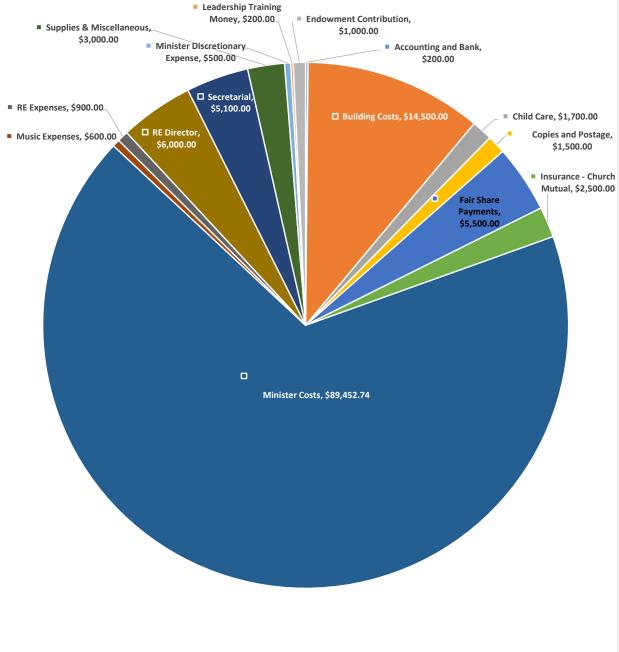
