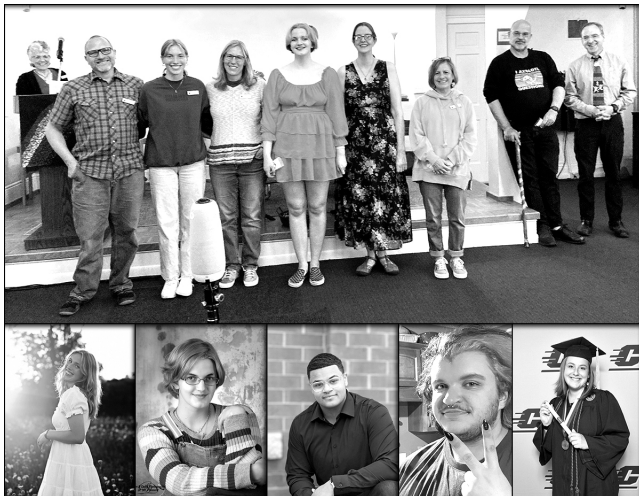

Covenant of UU Pagans

Solstice, or Litha means a stopping or standing still of the sun. It is the longest day of the year and the time when the sun is at its maximum elevation. This is also a time to celebrate growth and life for those who see balance in the world, and also a time to acknowledge that the sun will now begin to decline once more towards winter.
