Inclusive Justice of Michigan is a statewide coalition of faith and community leaders advocating for LGBTQI+ equality, inclusive of all spiritual traditions that promote the inherent dignity and worth of every human being as a matter of conviction.

We serve & advocate for LGBTQI+ persons' acceptance within religious and spiritual communities.



We partner with others to advocate for the equitable treatment of all in local, state, and federal public policies.

In January 2021 Inclusive Justice of Michigan announced that 200 religious leaders from Detroit to Marquette added their names to a statement calling on Michigan's elected officials to pass comprehensive federal and statewide LGBTQI+ nondiscrimination protections.

To encourage clergypersons to sign-on to the Michigan Clergy pledge to stand against harms caused by anti-LGBTQI+ discrimination and to declare the need for a federal response--a public document that will be publicized to the media and other partner organizations.

To encourage clergy, their congregations and other community leaders to participate in *Protecting* Democracy: RALLY for Full Equality at Michigan's Capitol Building on Wednesday, Sept. 21, 2022 at noon.

To encourage clergypersons to sign a virtual or paper postcard, stating their stand against harms caused by anti-LGBTQI+ discrimination, to be collected and sent to our legislators to inform them of the support from religious leaders for non-discrimination legislation.

To work with other organizations to get out the vote of people who support LGBTQI+ persons.
