## Article 3: Membership - adding new language (in red/bold)

## Current

3.2 The Fellowship may attract people who, for personal or other reasons, are unwilling to sign the Membership book and/or make an annual contribution of record. These people are still welcome and shall be referred to as "Friends." Friends do not have the power to vote and cannot be Board officers. Friends may be members of teams.

## Proposed

3.2 The Fellowship may attract people who, for personal or other reasons, are unwilling to sign the Membership book and/or make an annual contribution of record. These people are still welcome and shall be referred to as "Friends." Friends do not have the power to vote, cannot be Board officers, and cannot be chairs of teams. Friends may be members of teams.

## Article 10: Board Officers and Trustees-At-Large - removing the fourth sentence

## Current

10.0 The president shall act as the official representative of the Fellowship. The president shall preside at all business and Board meetings. The president shall form committees as needed, subject to the approval of the Board. The president shall also be responsible for assuring preparation of periodic audits of the Fellowship's financial status, with the proviso that no Member of the Board shall serve as auditor.
